**COVID ORDERS TERMINATED**

Considering Executive Proclamation Number 203-JBE-2021, signed by Governor John Bel Edwards on October 26, 2021, the Chief Judge acting on behalf of the Judges of the 24th Judicial District Court HEREBY ORDERS THAT:


Prior Orders 2021-006 and 2021-007 are terminated. There is no mask mandate in the Thomas F. Donelon Courthouse; however, judges may require masks and social distancing in their respective courtrooms.

Defendants being transported from Jefferson Parish Correctional Center shall continue to be rapid-tested for COVID infection prior to transport to the Thomas F. Donelon Courthouse. Inmates testing positive shall not be transported to the Courthouse.
